

End of Term update from ST.Anthony's School

Like most schools, the last half term has been a very busy one so the children and staff at St Anthony's are looking forward to a well-deserved rest this Christmas holidays.

We have marked the season of Advent by making individual promises that were linked together to make one enormous paper chain of the whole school's promises. It has been a visual reminder of how we are getting ready for Christ's coming at Christmas, with our older children understanding that we also prepare for Christ's second coming.

Fr Ansel kindly arranged for Fr John Cooke and Deacon Larry Murawski to attend our Advent Reconciliation Service last week. Children in Years 5 and 6 were invited to attend confession afterwards with sacramental reconciliation offered as well as a conversation with a member of the clergy for those who had not made their first Holy Communion. It was moving to see so many children come forward for this voluntarily as Fr Ansel and I continue to work to dispel feelings that confession is something to be nervous of. Fr Ansel also celebrated an Advent Mass this week, led by our Year 5 pupils.

Our children have performed six wonderful nativity performances: two from our Early Years classes, two from our Years 1 & 2 and two from our Years 3 & 4. Once again, our carol service was held at St Margaret Mary and led by Years 5 & 6. The day before, these children joined the parish Mass before staying on to rehearse their carol service. Our church was such a beautiful setting for this event, which retold the simple nativity story with traditional readings. It has been fantastic to have two opportunities this term to bring our children to the church.

In RE lessons, the children concluded their learning about Catholic Social Teaching and how we are all called to make a difference to others before they moved on to explore Advent and its messages of preparation.

This final week of term has been full of festive fun with our whole school Christmas lunch, an Early Years Christmas party (with a children's entertainer), a trip to the pantomime for Years 1 to 6, an 'Elfridges' Christmas fayre for children to buy gifts for their families and a Christmas jumper day and assembly that included a visit from Fr Christmas.

Crib Offering 2025— Knights of the Holy Sepulchre.
The Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem (Latin: *Ordo Equestris Sancti Sepulcri Hierosolymitani*, OESSH), also called the Order of the Holy Sepulchre or Knights of the Holy Sepulchre, is a Catholic order of knighthood under the protection of the Holy See. The pope is the sovereign of the order. The order creates canons as well as knights, with the primary mission to "support the Christian presence in the Holy Land"
