PARISH CONSULTATION

Statement from the Catholic Bishops of England on Sunday Obligation

"We are mindful of the certain fact that the Covid-19 virus is still circulating in society. Vaccines provide genuine protection against the worst effects of the virus, yet we recognise the legitimate fear on the part of some who otherwise desire to gather for Holy Mass. It is our continuing judgement, therefore, that it is not possible at the present time for all of the faithful to attend Mass on a Sunday thus fulfilling their duty to God. It is hoped that it will be possible for all Catholics in England and Wales to fulfil this most important Church precept, that of the Sunday Obligation, by the First Sunday in Advent 2021."

The Bishops invite us to use the Resource - The Day of the Lord as a way of restoring the Sunday Mass to its rightful centrality in our lives.

Coming to Church: We need to continue to be cautious and caring of those around us and mindful of those things that spread the virus and its variants. The responsibility for controlling the spread of Covid has been passed to us. By taking that responsibility seriously we can continue to show our appreciation for the efforts and sacrifices of those working in the Health sector.

Is there something we can do to help our fellow parishioners come safely back to Mass? Wearing a face covering? Taking care to not encroach on their personal space? Acting as a Welcomer/Steward? Offering a lift? Cleaning the Church? Delivering a Newsletter? Phoning a friend you haven't seen for a while?

Changes in Church:

All the Church benches are now available for use as seating; however the Paray Room and Lady Chapel are restricted to those who need extra space. **The Stewards/Welcomers are there to help you to keep safe.** If you (and your bubble) would like more space in the body of the Church, please use one of the signs that will be available on the Stewards/Welcomers Table in the Porch. e.g. **Keep Safe - Leave a Space** Please continue sanitising your hands on arrival at Church; 'sign in' and wear a face covering unless you have a reason that allows exemption.

Fr Rob will continue to wear a face mask and to sanitise his hands prior to distributing Communion.


