

End of Term report—ST. Anthony's School

The second half of an Autumn term in schools is always busy and this year has been no exception so our children and staff at St Anthony's are ready for a well-deserved rest this Christmas holidays.

The Catholic life of the school has been very much alive during Advent. We began Advent by making individual promises that were linked together in a class purple paper chain and then each class chain was joined to make one enormous paper chain of the whole school's promises. This has been hung in our hall to remind us all that we are getting ready for Christ's coming at Christmas, with our older children understanding that we also prepare for Christ's second coming.

Fr Ansel kindly arranged for Fr John Cooke, Fr Vincent Harvey and Deacons John Cumpstey and Larry Murawski to attend our Advent Reconciliation Service last week. Children in Years 5 and 6 were invited to attend confession afterwards with

Sacramental reconciliation offered as well as a conversation with a member of the clergy for those who had not made their first Holy Communion. It was overwhelming to see nearly every child come forward for this voluntarily. Fr Ansel and I are keen to dispel feelings that confession is an intimidating experience.

Altogether, we have put on six fabulous nativity performances: two from our Preschool & Year R classes, two from our Years 1 & 2 classes and two from our Years 3 & 4 classes. We also held our Carol Service at St Margaret Mary, which was led by Years 5 & 6 and it was a beautiful setting for the simple story they retold with traditional readings. The day before, these children joined the parish Mass before staying on to rehearse their carol service. It was lovely to see that some of our children recognised

parishioners from their previous visit for the feast day of St Margaret Mary. It has been a blessing to see friendships between the different generations and it makes me wish we were closer to the church so that we could do this more often.

In RE lessons, the children completed their learning about Catholic Social Teaching - how we are all called to make a difference to others and moved on to explore Advent and its messages of preparation.

This final week of term has been fun-packed with our whole school Christmas lunch, an Early Years Christmas party (with a children's entertainer), a trip to the pantomime for Years 1 to 6, a Christmas fayre for children to buy gifts for their families and a Christmas jumper day and assembly that included a visit from Fr Christmas. The staff collapsed in a heap of tinsel and glitter on Friday afternoon but it has been a fantastic term!


Come and work in our Catholic Schools

Crib Offering—Knights of Holy Sepulchre.

The usual donations tins will be available by the crib, but you can also make a donation on the Dona machine. The KHS is widely believed to date back to 1099 A.D., to the first crusade. For centuries their mission has been to support the Christian community in the Holy Land. Today, made up of 30,000 members from 40 countries, lay people, priests and religious, they financially support Christians in the Middle East, and, above all, pray for them. They fund works that support the Christians living in the Holy Land, thus ensuring that they survive and that the holy sites are still populated by Christians. The Knights help with practical projects to stabilise Christian communities. The key partner for the KHS in the Holy Land is the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem and through the Patriarchate, they fund-raise to maintain schools, formation, charitable and social activities.
