

Parish Pilgrimage to ST.John's Cathedral—Saturday 14th June (time to be confirmed)

In light of the Jubilee year, there will be a parish pilgrimage to St.John's Cathedral on 14th June. There will be and opportunity for Confession, Mass and Indulgence. Fr Ansel will hold a preparation meeting on Sat 31st May in the Parish Hall at 10am to explain the Jubilee year and Indulgence. After Mass, we will be meeting on Southsea Common to enjoy a Parish picnic..

Ash Wednesday starting with the Council of Nicea, established a 40-day fasting period before Easter. There was some debate about when this period should start, but in the fifth century, Pope Gregory officially moved the beginning of Lent from a Sunday to Its core practices—fasting, prayer, and repentance—are deeply biblical.

The heart of Ash Wednesday and Lent is about turning back to God. The 40 days of Lent reflect Jesus' time in the wilderness, where He fasted and prepared for His ministry. For many Christians, this season is a time of self-reflection, letting go of distractions, and drawing closer to God as they prepare their hearts for Easter, the celebration of Jesus' resurrection.

The story of Jesus' temptation in the wilderness is found in Matthew, Mark, and Luke. After being baptized, He spent 40 days fasting while Satan tempted Him three times, trying to take advantage of His hunger and exhaustion. But Jesus stood firm, responding with Scripture each time and refusing to give in. His victory over temptation is a powerful reminder that we can rely on God's Word and strength in our own struggles, too.

Gift Aid - Just a reminder if you offering is gift-aided, the envelope needs to be annotated with you specific number. Although we cannot have list on noticeboard anymore because of GDPR Rules, the list of names and numbers are kept in the Sacristy and also held by the main office—please do ask.

Mass Intentions. To book a Mass intention/s please contact the Parish office by phone, email or in person. If you leave an envelope outside office hours please can you put all the details on the envelope, particularly your name and contact number. The most important thing is that the sacrifice of the Mass is offered, but we cannot guarantee the date. If you make a donation via BACS, please include reference of 'Mass Int'. Thank you.
